TRACK 2: Grants to locally-led activities to collectively counter restrictions to civic space

Suggested Activities:

- Alliance building and strengthening among civil society in country to address the situation with an aim of cross-thematic involvement for impact. Outreach to other stakeholders for alliance building should take place (unless an alliance already exists).

A variety of activities can be supported depending on what local actors deem most relevant in the specific context. They can include but are not limited to:

- Advocacy and campaigns against restrictive laws
- Documentation
- Digital security
- Roundtable dialogues
- Early warning systems
- Self-protection trainings
- Expert advise
 - For example to empower CSOs to analyse risks and design responsive strategies.
- Engagement with other actors than civil society such as national human rights institutions, religious groups, local authorities, private sector etc. if relevant
- General support and capacity building of local human rights defenders
 - Individuals could be trained to provide this support in their local community
- Conflict resolution
- Legal reform efforts
- Legal litigation including public interest litigation
- Legal researches or studies
- Other relevant activities identified by the applicant
